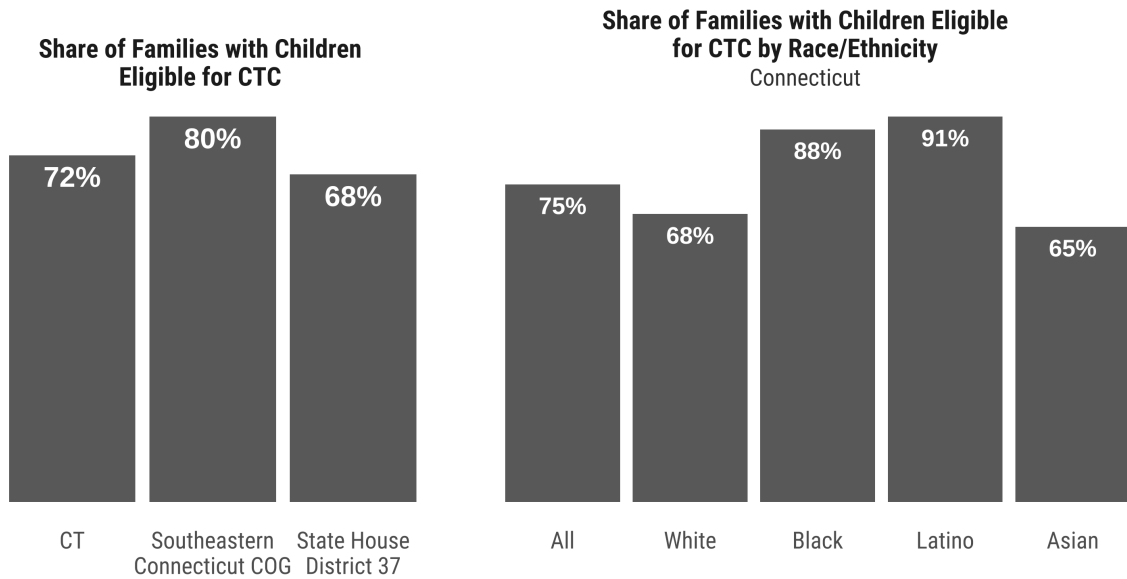


# Proposed Child Tax Credit (CTC) Report: State House District 37

## Child Tax Credit Eligibility<sup>1</sup>

| Connecticut                  | 1.4M             | 375K                   | 268K              | 72               | \$306M        |
| Southeastern Connecticut COG | 114K             | 28K                    | 22K               | 80               | \$25M         |
| State House District 37      | 10K              | 2,429                  | 1,648             | 68               | \$2M          |
