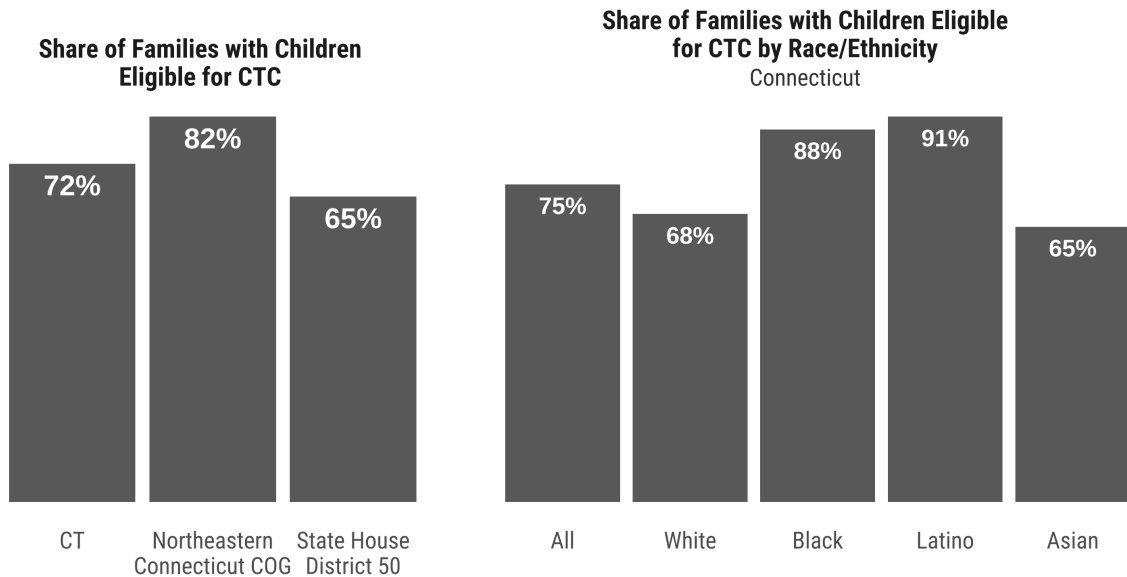


Proposed Child Tax Credit (CTC) Report: State House District 50
