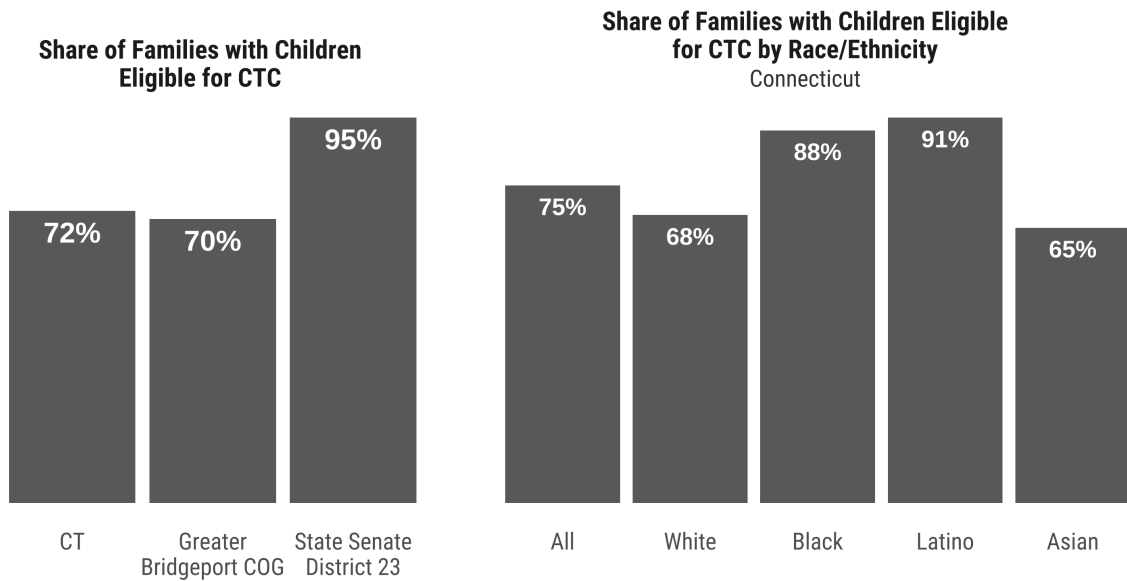


# Proposed Child Tax Credit (CTC) Report: State Senate District 23

## Child Tax Credit Eligibility<sup>1</sup>

|                          | Total Households | Families with Children | Eligible Families | Percent Eligible | Refund Amount |
|--------------------------|------------------|------------------------|-------------------|------------------|---------------|
| Connecticut              | 1.4M             | 375K                   | 268K              | 72               | \$306M        |
| Greater Bridgeport COG   | 117K             | 34K                    | 24K               | 70               | \$27M         |
| State Senate District 23 | 32K              | 9,050                  | 8,565             | 95               | \$10M         |
