

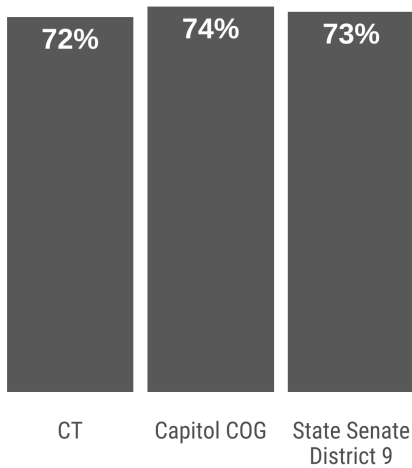

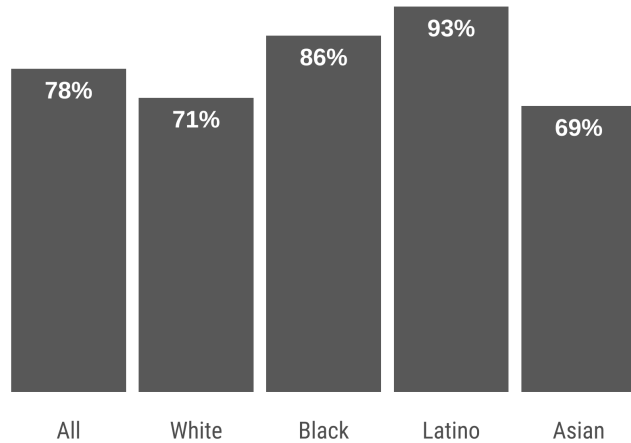
## Child Tax Credit Eligibility<sup>1</sup>

| Connecticut             | 1.4M             | 375K                   | 268K              | 72               | \$306M        |
| Capitol COG             | 387K             | 103K                   | 76K               | 74               | \$87M         |
| State Senate District 9 | 42K              | 9,813                  | 7,172             | 73               | \$8M          |
